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## SCIENTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAM™

### **Program Summary**

The Scientist in Residence Program creates partnerships between scientists and elementary classroom teachers. Together, each team creates and delivers a custom-made unit for the teachers' students, including 6 stellar science lessons that are *designed to inspire*.

Collaboration is the foundation of the program. Each partnership includes one scientist and two teachers from the same school. Scientists contribute their passion for the natural world and their specific science knowledge, skills and experiences; teachers share their passion for education and their expertise in pedagogy, curriculum and meeting students' learning needs.

Each partnership receives \$1,000 to support their unit. They can choose to spend this funding on any combination of science equipment, supplies or field trips. After the unit is done, scientists and teachers document their work for future reference in comprehensive lesson plans.
